POINT-CUMULATIVE SYSTEM OF ASSESSMENT OF KNOWLEDGE IN THE DISCIPLINE OF MICROBIOLOGY AND VIROLOGY

POINTS ARE CALCULATED ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

1. **Points are awarded for control work for each module**. Each control work includes test tasks and one theoretical question, the implementation of practical skills and filling out a workbook.

Criteria for evaluating tasks in a test form:

- «5» balls– 91-100% correct answers
- «4» balls 81-90% correct answers
- «3» balls 71-80% correct answers
- «0» balls 0-70% correct answers

Criteria for assessing knowledge of theoretical material:

- "5" points the answer fully corresponds to the question asked, additional literature was used
- "4" points the answer is complete corresponds to this question, but there are inaccuracies
- "3" points the answer is incomplete, corresponds to the question asked
- "0" points the answer is incorrect and does not correspond to the question asked

Criteria for assessing practical skills:

- "2" points correct implementation of practical skills
- "1" point implementation of practical skills with errors
- "0" points not fulfilling practical skills

Criteria for evaluating the completion of the workbook

- "2" points correct and timely completion of the workbook
- "1" point filling out the workbook with errors or untimely completion
- "0" points not filling out the workbook

2. Working out (otrabotki):

- Practicing missing lessons and control works are accepted at the department during the semester according to the schedule. When working out missing control works for a good reason, points are awarded in full (see evaluation criteria above).
- Missed practical classes outside the control lessons are worked out without scoring points.
- When working out missed control lessons without good reason, all points received are divided by 2.
- When scoring less than 40% of the total number of points for the semester (less than 34 points), the student is obliged to get the missing points in the practice, but not more than 50% of the maximum points scored.
- Upon presentation of a certificate "without working off" for the midterm control lesson, 3 points are awarded for theory and tests, as well as 1 point for the implementation of practical skills and the design of a workbook after they are checked by the teacher.

3. Penalties:

If you miss a lecture without a valid reason, points are deducted: 1 point for each missed lecture.

- 4. Additional points are awarded to students participating in the SSS (student scientific society), and are taken into account in the autumn semester:
- Poster presentation 3 points, abstracts for the conference 3 points
- Oral presentation or video film at conferences 5 points
- Diploma for 1st-3rd place in Russian conferences 10 points
- Diploma for 1-3 place in foreign conferences 14 points
- An article in RSCI journals 5 points, in foreign collections 7 points, in HAC journals 10 points
- Winner of regional, all-Russian and international exhibitions 10 points

• Winners of the annual competition in microbiology and the annual Olympiad in microbiology receive 3 points for third place, 5 points for second place, and 7 points for first place.

SCORE COUNTING:

In total, you can score a maximum of 84 points for the semester - this is 100%. Total for the year: 84 points for the spring semester + 84 for the fall semester = 168 points. 168 points is 100%, 152 points is 91%, 136 points is 81%, 119 points is 71%. Exemption from the first stage of the exam - practical skills - is subject to a set of 81-100% points.

Students who score 91-100% on the basis of the results of two semesters are exempted from the exam with a grade of "5" (excellent), which is entered into the statement and record book on the day of the exam.

Students who score 81-90% of the scores at the end of two semesters are exempted from the exam with a grade of "4" (good), which is entered into the statement and record book on the day of the exam.

Students who scored 71-80% of the scores at the end of two semesters pass the first stage of the exam - practical skills and are exempted from the exam with a grade of "3" (satisfactory), which is entered into the statement and record book on the day of the exam. If the student does not agree with the sum of the points scored and the grade obtained, then he takes the exam on a general basis.

Students who score 70% or less at the end of two semesters pass all three stages of the exam: practical skills, and then in the computer class the 2nd and 3rd stages.

NB! All students involved in SSS (student scientific society) are exempted from the practical stage of the exam, regardless of the number of points scored.

EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR INTERIM CERTIFICATION IN MICROBIOLOGY AND VIROLOGY USING A COMPUTER FORM:

Stage I (practical skills) - "pass" or "fail".

Stage II (testing) - the number of correct answers

70% and less – mark «2» 71-80% - mark «3» 81-90% - mark «4» 91- 100% - mark «5»
